



COTM Conditions

CONDITIONS
The Board of Assessors of COTM may place a condition on the registration of individuals who are on or moving onto the Register of Practising Members. The Board will determine what specific features for reporting or supervision exist for individuals on a case by case basis.
CONTINUING COMPETENCE
An individual who has been on the Non-practising Register who transfers to the Practising Register may be entitled to an extension of 90 days to complete necessary COTM Continuing Competence Program requirements. The Continuing Competence condition does not generally trigger additional supervision requirements.
CURRENCY
An occupational therapist who has some hours of practice but who is unable to meet the COTM Currency requirement of 600 hours of practice in the three year period immediately preceding the date of application for renewal may be eligible for a three-month extension to acquire the missing hours. During this period the member would have a condition placed on their Practising Registration rather than be added moved to the Register of Provisional Members as a Supervised Practice Candidate with the requirement to complete a COTM Re-entry program. The condition will specify any additional supervision requirements on a case by case basis.
DOCUMENTS
For individuals who are unable to provide required documentary evidence to COTM, the college has the option to apply a condition on the individual's registration. COTM will determine if any additional supervision is a feature of this arrangement on a case by case basis.
HEALTH
An occupational therapist for whom an illness or injury is present which has the potential to interfere with the safe and effective practice of occupational therapy will have a condition applied to their registration. The condition will specify the supervision, limitations on practice, and reporting requirements associated with the member's specific situation.
LANGUAGE
An individual who needs additional support and supervision to achieve language proficiency in areas of high risk communications may be moved from being on the Register of Provisional Registration as a Supervised Practice Candidate to the Register of Practising Members with a condition. The condition will provide for additional supervision and support in areas where there are significant risks associated with written and / or spoken communication that falls below an acceptable performance standards.
SUPERVISED PRACTICE
A condition for additional supervision and support will be placed on a member's registration when such a need has been identified and is defined through an agreement between COTM and the member.
